Upon completing this card, they will hand it to the Steward of the Section for presentation to the Judge who may, question the competitor on any points of their judgement, or any feature in connection with subjects being judged.
- 4. The Judge, in making the awards, shall take into consideration the correctness of placing of the subjects and the reasons given.
- 5. No entry fee is required, but entry is subject to the approval of the Show Committee.
