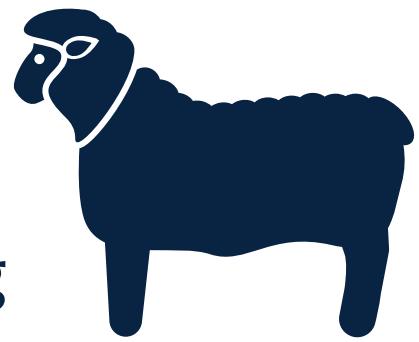

Nominations

- All Classes are open to persons not over 25 years of age on first day of the Show.
- Winners of any State Junior Judging Competition will not be eligible in a similar breed class at this Show.
- For each class no less than four animals of a prescribed breed shall be chosen each year.
- Each competitor will be provided with a card on which he/she will place the animals in their order of merit and give reasons for doing so. Upon completing the card, it will be handed to the Steward for presentation to the Judge who may, if he desires, question the Competitor on any points in his judgment, or any feature in connection with the sheep being judged.
- The judge, in making his awards, shall take into consideration the correctness of placing of the animals and the reasons given.
- No entry fee is required, but entry is subject to approval of the Show Committee.
