NB: Ear tag numbers must be recorded on entry forms for ALL animals being entered

STUD CATTLE REGULATIONS

1. All Females over 30 months must be in calf or have a calf at foot.
2. Exhibits must be bona fide property of the Exhibitor at the time of showing.
3. The Society has the right at any time to cancel the entry of an exhibit without assigning any reason therefore, notwithstanding prior acceptance of such entry, provided that, if an entry be cancelled except for a reason for which the exhibitor is responsible, the relative entry fees, if any, upon cancellation of the entry, shall be refunded to the exhibitor.
4. Herd Book certificates must be available for inspection by the Stewards.
5. Full particulars must be stated on entry form of names of animal, age, tattoo and/or firebrand and number, and Herd Book number of Sire and Dam.
6. Any animal, which by judging day has become ineligible for a class in which it is entered shall not compete in that Class.
7. The Society reserves the right, if it so chooses, to transfer an animal from a class in which it has been entered, but for which on judging day it is ineligible to compete, to a class for which it has become eligible to compete.
8. Each exhibit in a single class and the leading animal in group classes shall wear the numbered NECK CARD assigned to it as an exhibit whilst parading before the Judge.
9. All Bulls 15 months and over must be secured by a neck strap at all times when stalled.
10. All Bulls 12 months and over must be nose ringed.
11. All animals paraded before the Judge or taking part in the Grand Parade must be led with nose grips and are thoroughly tractable.
12. In the event of the Judge deciding the cattle are not worthy of the prize, no prize will be awarded.
13. No stock shall leave the grounds without the consent of the Cattle Stewards.
14. No cattle can compete in any other classes than those for which they are entered on the Entry Form unless transferred by the Stewards.
15. In awarding the Championships the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative sub section shall be eligible to compete. In awarding the Reserve Championships, the first prize winner in the relative sex in each class of the relative sub section other than the exhibit to which the Championship has been awarded shall be eligible to compete, together with the second prize winner from the class from which the Champion is drawn.
16. No prize winner over the age of 20 months is eligible for the Junior Championship.
17. If a Champion or Junior Champion shall be disqualified or shall be found to be unqualified to compete in the Championship or Junior Championship, it shall be awarded to the animal which was awarded Reserve Champion.
18. All stud cattle shall be led for judging.
19. Any Exhibitor who fails to lead his cattle in the Grand Parade may forfeit any prizes won, at the discretion of the Stewards.
20. The age of all Stud Beef Cattle shall be the actual age up to 20th May 2017. An animal born on or prior to 20th May 2016 shall not be eligible for the under 12 months class. A similar provision shall apply to the other age classes when calculating the age of birth of each animal, which must be entered on the Entry Form.
21. Championship Ribbons will not be awarded in non-competitive classes.

22. All Exhibitors in-group classes whilst parading before the Judge must wear all ribbons awarded in single classes.
23. The Committee authorises any two official representatives of respective breed societies to have the power to prevent any Exhibitor from showing cattle, which fail to reach the minimum standards expected by that breed Society.
24. NO cattle will be permitted on the grounds as non-competitive

HEALTH REGULATIONS

1. ALL cattle must have a readable NLIS tag in their ear prior to entering the showgrounds
2. All exhibitors must adhere to any relevant regulations and requirements under the Queensland Biosecurity Act (2014)

Conditions of Entry:

1. All Classes are open to persons not over 25 years of age on the first day of Show,
2. Four Exhibits shall be paraded for Judging.
3. Each competitor will be provided with a card on which they will place the subjects in their order of merit and give reasons for doing so. Upon completing this card, they will hand it to the Steward of the Section for presentation to the Judge who may, question the competitor on any points of their judgement, or any feature in connection with subjects being judged.
4. The Judge, in making the awards, shall take into consideration the correctness of placing of the subjects and the reasons given.
5. No entry fee is required, but entry is subject to the approval of the Show Committee.
6. Time limit for judging, completing card: Half an hour.
