A. Sheep Presentation Requirements & Section Information

1. Sheep must be on the showgrounds by 9.00am on Saturday the 19th May 2018. Sheep may be unloaded after 3.00PM on Friday the 18th of May by arrangement with the Steward to assist with receivals. If there is anything the Show Society can do to make it easier to deliver and pick up Sheep, please advise the steward.
2. Judging will commence at 10.00am on Saturday 19th May 2018
3. Wool Shedding Breeds will be unloaded, penned and loaded in separated facilities;
4. Free Lucerne Hay and Water will be available to Sheep staying overnight on the 18th and 19th.

B. Biosecurity Requirements

Longreach Show Society has a duty of care to ensure that the interests of participants are protected by ensuring that the biosecurity risks associated with the showing of sheep are understood and managed.

1. Notification of Entries by email, phone or letter must completed by Noon on Friday 18th of May.
2. All Sheep deliveries must be accompanied by:
 - A. A completed NVD (National Vendor Declaration) and
 - B. A National Sheep Health Statement (SHS). A completed SHS is required at entry or at the latest, upon delivery. Sheep Health Statement Forms will be provided at delivery and can be completed on arrival, or are available for download online at www.longreachannualshow.com.au

Lambing dates to be stipulated.

CLASS 3: 0 to 9 months wool

CLASS 4: 10 months wool and over

Section C: Pen of 5 Flock Merino Ewes showing 4 or more permanent teeth.

CLASS 5: 0 to 9 months

CLASS 6: 10 months wool and over.

CLASS 7: Grand Champion Flock Ewe all classes. Ewe to be selected by exhibitor. One from each pen.

CLASS 8: The John Macarthur Memorial Trophy: Champion Pen of Flock Merino Ewes Bred in Central Western Queensland. Please specify eligibility upon nomination.

CLASS 9: Reserve Champion Pen of 5 Flock Merino Ewes Bred in Central Western Queensland.
