## DEFINITIONS:

**OPEN HORSE:** All horses are eligible for an open event

**BEGINNER HORSE AND BEGINNER RIDER:** Riders are not to have won an open age challenge. Horses not to have won a challenge that has been contested by open age riders. (A horse that has won a juvenile, youth or junior challenge is eligible for nomination in a beginner class.)

**NOVICE HORSE:** A horse that has won a beginner horse, under 5, district, maiden, rookie becomes a novice. Can be ridden by an open rider.

**RIDER STATUS:** Open - 18 years and over  
Youth - under 18 years  
Junior - under 13 years

**CHALLENGE:** An event that has two or more disciplines.

## POINT SYSTEM FOR FOR ALL CLASSES

DRY WORK	100 POINTS
OBSTACLE	100 POINTS

## CLASS:

**1. OPEN CHALLENGE:** Riders to be 18 years and over. To be judged over two sections—Dry Work and Cattle Work. (Season Permitting—if no cattle available An obstacle course will be added) Entry \$10.00.

First \$35.00, Second \$30.00, Third \$25.00, Fourth \$20.00 and Fifth \$15.00.  
Ribbons to Fifth Place.

**4. JUVENILE CHALLENGE** Riders to be under 18 years. Helmets must be worn (A.S.3838). To be judged over 2 sections—Dry work & Cattle Work. Season Permitting: if no cattle available and obstacle course will be added) Entry \$10.00.

First \$35.00, Second \$30.00, Third \$25.00, Fourth \$20.00 and Fifth \$15.00. Ribbons to Fifth Place.

**5. JUNIOR CHALLENGE** Riders to be under 13 years. NO NOMINATION FEE. Helmets must be worn. (A.S.3838). To be judges over 2 sections—Dry Workout and Obstacle. First \$20.00, Second \$15.00, Third \$10.00, Fourth \$5.00, Fifth \$5.00. Ribbons to Fifth Place.
