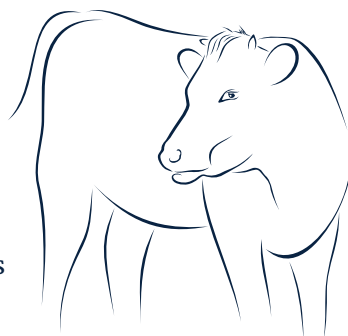
2022 LONGREACH SHOW | 13-14 MAY

Entry Regulations

1. Exhibits must be bona fide property of the Exhibitor at the time of showing.
2. The Society reserves the right, if it so chooses, to transfer an animal from a class in which it has been entered, but for which on judging day it is ineligible to compete, to a class for which it has become eligible to compete.
3. In the event of the Judge deciding the cattle are not worthy of the prize, no prize will be awarded.
4. No stock shall leave the grounds without the consent of the Cattle Stewards.
5. If a Champion shall be disqualified or shall be found to be unqualified to compete in the Championship it shall be awarded to the animal which was awarded Reserve Champion.
6. NO cattle will be permitted on the grounds as non-competitive
7. ALL cattle must have a readable NLIS tag in their ear prior to entering the showgrounds.
8. All exhibitors must adhere to any relevant regulations and requirements under the Queensland Biosecurity Act (2014)
